Dear Elected Official,

I'm writing to let you know that the FAA has made the decision to prepare an Environmental Assessment of the proposed amendments to two existing departure procedures at Hollywood Burbank Airport. The agency made this decision after carefully considering public comments it received at and following two November 2018 workshops about the proposal.

The Environmental Assessment will evaluate the potential environmental impacts of the proposed amendments to the OROSZ and SLAPP procedures, and any reasonable alternatives to the proposed amendments. The Environmental Assessment will not include a re-evaluation of the Southern California Metroplex Record of Decision.

The Environmental Assessment will be prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and FAA regulations and policies. The process will include community involvement.

The FAA is in the process of developing a timeline for preparing the Environmental Assessment. Please continue to monitor the FAA's Burbank Community Involvement website for updates on the Environmental Assessment schedule.
